*Mastering Aboriginal Inclusion* is a revolutionary human resource program that represents the combined work of the Aboriginal Human Resource Council and a dedicated group of Canada’s leading diversity companies and organizations. This innovative program offers the first-ever training and self-study modules designed specifically to help employers create workplaces of Aboriginal inclusion.

Three years in the making and drawing on an unprecedented array of initiatives and practices, *Mastering Aboriginal Inclusion* marks a potential turning point for companies interested in recruiting, retaining and advancing Aboriginal workers. The five self-study module series is complemented by a two-day workshop that helps senior executives, managers and human resource practitioners advance inclusion strategies to meet their business objectives.
